

SELF INSPECTION CHECKLIST FOR WELL HEAD INTEGRITY

Is the well at least		
5' from any pits, crawl spaces, and basements?		
10' away from any sewer lines which have watertight joints?		
25' from any ponds, lakes, streams, creeks, or surface waters?		
50' from any septic tanks or aerobic treatment units?		
50' from sewer lines without watertight joints?		
50' from any barnyards?		
75' from any septic leachfields, field lines, or mounds?		
75' from any manure piles?		
200' from any unused, open, or abandoned wells?		
Construction for Drilled Wells		
Does the well have		
A casing which extends at least 8" above the ground if not in a pit?		
A watertight cap?		
A vented cap (with properly screened vents)?		
A good, tight cap seal (no loose or missing bolts or broken gaskets)?		
A good seal between the electrical conduit and the well cap?		
(some wells may not have an electrical conduit)		
Construction for Driven Wells (also called "Point" or "Sandpoint" wells)		
Is the floor sealed around the well?		
Are all connections secure?		
Construction for Well Pits (also called "Frost" pits)		
Is the pit structurally sound?		
Does the pit prevent the entry of water into the pit?		
Is the pit free of standing water?		
Does the pit have a watertight lid and cover?		
Is the height of the well above the pit floor at least 12"?	П

Hand-dug Wells (considered an unsafe water source)		
Has the well been properly sealed?		

*If there are any marks in the "No" column, consult the Boone County Health Department or an Illinois licensed water well or water well pump installation contractor and correct any construction deficiencies. Well pits which are not in compliance must be properly abandoned. Permits are required for well modifications, well sealings, well drillings, and well deepenings.








This well cap has been compromised and the well height is less than 8".



This well pit cover is not structurally sound or watertight.



This well pit is flooded.



This pit well is less than 12" high in the pit.

According to Code, all of these pits (D-F) need to be abandoned and the wells need to be extended up above grade, have pitless adapters installed, and proper vented caps. Permits required in Boone County for this type of work.
